# 36 HOURS IN WASHINGTON

Honor Flight DFW is an all-volunteer not-for-profit 501(c)(3) organization whose sole purpose is to honor veterans who have given so much and ask for little in return.

Over 1,400 veterans have traveled with HFDFW. The average age of those traveling in 2016 was 92 years old. It cost about a \$1,000 to travel one veteran.

Safety is our number one priority. Each veteran travels with an assigned guardian (the veterans prefer to call them 'butlers') who tends to the needs of the veteran to ensure safety and comfort of the veterans. Guardian's pay for their own travel expenses.

For many of these heroes, this is the first real expression of gratitude they have received. They laid their lives on the line for our country, our freedom, and for the lives we enjoy today. Many of them say, "I thought no one remembered."
